

Josimah Baby Bank sleeping aid guidelines

We check all items before we give them out to our families and if the item doesn't meet our standards as those set by government legislation, we will not accept them.

This guidance refers to all sleeping aid: Moses basket, bassinets, sleeping box, cot beds, carry cot, travel cots and toddler bed.

The items suitable to be rehomed must comply with British Standard Institute BS EN 716-1:2017.

We cannot accept the cot/bed, if there are more than two fingers width between the mattress and the side of the cot.

- > We do not use cots that are more than 10 years' old
- > Must not have been recycled
- > Cots should have a firm base either slated or one board
- > Mattresses provided have to be new and must conform to flammability standards
 BS EN 597-1:2015
- > We will not accept second hand mattresses
