

Josimah Baby Bank Travel system guidance

We check all items that come in to be donated to a list of criteria set by trading standard guidelines. If an item does not meet these requirements we will not accept the item.

A comprehensive detail of the safety requirements and test methods for pushchairs, prams and carry cot can be found on government website.

The items must simply conform to the following three points:

- Conform to British Standard institute **BS EN 1466 or BS EN 1888-1:2018** (information is usually found on the frame or seat covering).
- A permanent notice on the buggy must state: "Children should be harnessed at all times.... Overloading, incorrect folding and the use of non- approved accessories may damage or break this"
- Instructions must be provided either original or reprinted from the internet.

If we are accepting an umbrella style buggy they must be fitted with a hinge cover if it is a Maclaren model and it's doesn't have one, it can be ordered for free direct from Maclaren.
