

DONATION POLICY

Josimah Baby Bank values every item given to us; we are aware donations may have sentimental attachment and parents or carers have given us their baby's precious things to help a baby in need.

This document sets out our policy on what we do with your donations so you can have confidence we will use them responsibly and sensitively.

Before donating, please do check that the items are clean and safe for use. As we are only a small team of volunteers, we would not be able to do lots of deep cleaning and laundry. Hence, we are asking our donors to please ensure the donated items have been washed, cleaned, in good and safe conditions for use.

By donating your pre-loved items to Josimah Baby Bank, you are agreeing that we may use or dispose of your donation in accordance with this policy.

- 1. Josimah Baby Bank (JBB) has the right to distribute items as it is deemed fit to people in need of her service as listed on the website. www.josimahbabybank.org
- 2. Surplus clothing or other items that we cannot use but in good conditions would be passed on to other charities who offer similar services or charity shops.
- 3. Unsuitable Items not fit for purpose (ripped, too worn out, stained, or damaged) would be sent to the recycling center.
- 4. Josimah baby bank has the right to refuse items if it is not in good or safe conditions.
- 5. Only 2 large boxes/bags are allowed at any one time due to the availability of space.

If you are not happy with any of the statements above, unfortunately, we will not be able to accept your donations. You may wish to consider donating to other charities.
